If one of your parents has been killed or permanently disabled on the job, we can help you pay for a post-high school education.

To Qualify you must answer yes to all of the following questions:

1. Are you the natural, adopted, or step-child of, or fully dependent on, a worker killed or permanently disabled in a compensable work-related accident or by an occupational disease during the course and scope of employment with a Colorado-based employer?
2. Was your parent or family entitled to receive benefits under the Colorado Workers' Compensation Act?
3. Will you be at least 16 years old but less than 25 at the time of application?
4. Do you have a high school diploma or GED, or are you a high school senior in good standing?

You must also demonstrate financial need. Academic achievement, aptitude, extracurricular activities, grade point average, employment, and community service are considered. The scholarship is intended for any accredited undergraduate college or vocational program.
